Organization	10	Presentation does not follow the scientific method and is not organized	Presentation mostly follows scientific method but could improve on organization	Presentation follows scientific method (use research paper outline as your guide) in the proper sequential order.
Content (oral explanation)	10	Student does not seem to understand their research project and is not able to interpret results.	Student shows a good understanding of research project, but is missing some important details	Student shows a full understanding of background material, calculations done, and is able to interpret their results
Presentation: (slides)	10	Student needs major improvements on presentation, does not reference others' work and does not clearly display data	Student creates a good presentation but could improve on displaying data and has a few errors in referencing other work.	Student thoughtfully creates presentation, displays data clearly, and properly cites others' work
Time-limit	5	Student is 2 minutes or more longer or shorter than the allotted 5 minutes per presentation; Note: students will be asked to stop at 7 minutes.	Students presentation is 3-3.5 or 6.5-7 minutes.	Student times their presentation to be very close to the 5 minute time frame
